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Context

- 1] Joseph been sold into slavery in Egypt by brother (37:28)
- 2] Bought by Potiphar rise to have everything left in his charge (39:6)
- 3] Set up by Potiphar's wife on a charge of rape prison (39:19, 20)
- 4] Rise to charge of prison Pharaoh's Cup bearer and baker, interpreted dreams (ch40)
- 5] Cup bearer restored but did not remember Joseph (40:23)
- ??? Why was Joseph SO confident? (16)

Pharaoh's dreams (1-7)

1] two full years passed

Cf two full days - on the first day (3rd day) very early in the morning (Lk24:1)?

God does not hurry!

God is in perfect - control of time and space

2] dream – standing by/out of the Nile

Nb 'hapi' Nile god, chief amongst their gods

3] 7 fat cows eaten by 7 thin cows / 7 healthy ears of corn swallowed by 7 thin

Joseph's recall (8-14)

1] Pharaoh 'troubled' – wisemen and magicians? (8)

nb Egyptian wise men and magicians (Ex 6:10-13; 7:11)

cf convict world of sin righteousness and judgement (John 16;8)

- 2] Chief cupbearer (9-13)
- a) shortcomings (9)

Nb 'reminded' (40:23)

God prompts people to remember at the right time

b) speak to Pharaoh in third person (10)

cf God – first person 'I am who I am' (Ex 3:14) nb Jews not use that name

c) Cup bearer and baker dreams -young Hebrew interpreted correctly (11-13) nb chief baker 'impaled' (40:22)

3] Sent for Joseph – shaved, changed clothes (!) (14)

nb lit. 'run out of the pit'

new clothes cf coat of many colours (Gen 37:3)

Be ready to respond to God's call.

Pharaohs dream interpreted (15 -32)

- 1] Pharaoh and Joseph (15, 16)
- a) Pharaoh to Joseph dreams but none to interpret (15)
- b) Joseph to Pharaoh I can't but God can (16)
- Cf God gives interpretation (40:8)

'it is not me' = one word in Hebrew – an explosive answer!

Nb not to us, not to us, but to your name be the glory (Ps115:1)

this night your life will be required of you (Lk12:20)

God alone controls the future

Take no credit from God – give Him all the Glory

2] Pharaoh retells dreams (17-24)

- a) graphically scrawny etc (cf 19)
- b) text tells in full
- 3] Joseph interpretation (25-32)
- a) the dreams (25-27)
- 1) same meaning
- 2) 7 yrs plenty then 7 yrs famine

Cf 7 days God made the heavens and the earth (Gen 2:2)

- *God alone may reveal the future to people*
- b) the purpose of God (28)
- *God does what He wills*
- c) the effect (29-31)
- d) the reason (32)

nb God's sovereign will (Psalm 33:11, Daniel 4:25; Acts 5:39)

Joseph's plan (33-40)

- 1] 'volunteered' (continued but didn't put his own name forward)
- 2] 'discerning and wise' (33)

Cf The children of Issachar had understanding of the times (1 Chron 12:32)

- *God's men are 'discerning and wise'*
- *Do not push yourself forward in God's economy, you don't have to.*
- 3] practicalities (34 -36)
- 4] Pharaoh's response (37-40)
- a) seemed good to Pharaoh and officials (37)
- *Hear / believe/ receive God's Word*
- b) a man on whom is the spirit of God? (38)
- *GRACE God may put His Spirit in one of His creatures*
- c) Joseph discerning and wise (39)
- d) you (40)
- 1) in charge of palace / all my people
- 2) second in command to Pharaoh

Cf only with regard to the throne cf with Potiphar (39:6)

40 All things under him (Matt 28:18)

Humble – exalted (Matt 5:5; Phil 2:10f)

Second in command cf Mordecai (Esther 10:3)

At the right hand of God (Mt 26:64; Mk16:19; Lk22:69; Acts 7:55)

The Father is greater than I (John 14:28)

- *JESUS Only in respect of His throne is the Father greater than the Son*
- * After humbling yourself, in God's time, expect to be exalted*

MP God reveals his purposes through wise and discerning servant(s)

KV Since God has made all this known to you, there is no-one so discerning and wise as you (39)

???Joseph was so confident because he must have been 'one' with God (16)
