#### **Context**

- 1] Joseph sold into slavery in Egypt by his jealous brothers (37:28)
- 2] Bought by Potiphar. Captain of Pharaoh's guard. (39:1)
- 3] Rose to be his second in command (39:9)
- 4] Falsely accused of rape of P's wife and sent to Pharaoh's prison (39:20)

## (1-4a) the prison

- 1] The situation (1-3)
  - a) People
    - 1) King of Egypt

*Nb* repeated (1, 5) thereafter 'Pharaoh'.

2) Cup bearer and baker

*Cf bread and wine (Lk22:19, 20)* 

b) Imprisoned in house of Potiphar

Nb that he had previously been in charge of (39:4)

Cf Jesus equal to God .. took the form of a slave (Phil 2:6)

2] Joseph's charges (4)

a) captain of the guard

nb = Potiphar (39:1)

b) assigned to Joseph

nb still principal servant

\*God unseen directs our paths.\*

\*Trust the Lord to assign you to the right people / place\*

## (4b-8) the dreams

1] After sometime (4b)?

Nb years past?

A day is like a thousand years (2 Pet 3:8)

- 2] dream the same night (5)
  - a) 'unnecessary' repeat of Cup bearer, baker, king of Egypt
  - b) same night but separate meaning

nb dreams - Joseph (37:6&9); Pharaoh (41:1ff)

- 3] reaction (6-8a)
  - a) dejected (6)
  - b) disappointment showed (7)
  - c) no interpretation (8a)
- 3] Joseph's response (8b)
  - a) interpretations belong to God

\*God is supreme / sovereign\* \*God rules all knowledge and revelation.\*

\*GRACE God reveals His purposes through His prophets\*

cf how could I do such a wicked thing and sin against God (39:9)

b) tell me your dream

nb confident able to interpret - had the mind of God

\*Trust God to reveal Himself to you\*

## (9-13) the cupbearer

- 1] the dream (9-11)
  - a) the vine
- cf Israel (Is 7:1ff); Jesus (John 15:1ff)
  - b) 3 branches
  - c) the fruit...cup....Pharaoh's hand
- 2] The interpretation (12,13)
  - a) 3 branches = 3 days (12)
  - b) Pharaoh will restore you (13)
- \* Be bold in declaring the Word of God\*

### (14, 15) the appeal

1] but when all goes well remember to show me kindness

Nb 'Kindness' is a covenant word (cf 39:21)

Cf said nothing when originally imprisoned (39:20)

- 2] to Pharaoh (!) get me out
- 3] Unfairly carried from land imprisoned in dungeon
- \*Speak / appeal as the Lord directs you\*

#### (16-19) the baker

- 1] the dream (16,17)
  - a) saw a favourable interpretation
  - b) 3 baskets on head & birds eating
- 2] the interpretation (18,19)
  - a) 3 days
  - b) put to death / impaled on pole (nb crucified) birds eat your flesh
- 19 The Word of God a two edged sword (Heb 4:12)

Cursed is anyone hung on a tree (Deut 21:23; Gal 3:23)

# (20-23) Resolution

- 1] The event (20a) 3<sup>rd</sup> day Pharaoh's b'day.
- Cf Pilate and Festival releasing a slave (Mk 15:6)
- 2] fulfilment of dreams one released one put to death (20b-22)
- Cf The 'king' acknowledged (Lk 19:38)

The 'king' crucified (Lk 23:38)

One freed, 1 crucified (Mk 15:15)

- \*God knows / orders the future\*
- (21 The chief cup bearer (the wine) was restored)
- (22 The baker (the bread) was hanged on a tree (crucified)
- 3] Chief cup bearer?
  - a) didn't remember cf (14)
  - b) forgot Joseph

nb part of God's timing – Judah not repented yet, Pharaoh dream in 2 yrs time cfI will not forget you (Is 49:15)

\*Trust that God is directing your paths /timing even when things look bleak\*
