Romans 11:11-24 Gentile believers – appreciate your place 19.01.20

(NIV Pew Bible page no: 1138)

Context

- 1] Paul to Gentile church in Rome
 - 1) lays out the Good news we are set right with God through faith in Jesus (chs 1-8)
 - 2) deal with God's place of the Jews (chs 9-11)
- 2] Gospel everyone, Jew and Gentile, who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved (10:12f)
- 3] Jews = disobedient/disbelieving (10:21) but a remnant is saved by God through grace (11:6)

Has God lost it? (11 12)

1] I ask (11a, cf 10:19; 11:1),

2] Does the Jewish 'stumble' lead to a fall (11b) (fall = final separation with God) *Ie Is God finished with the Jews?*

3] By no means (11c)

Ie absolutely / emphatically not! (cf 6:2; 11:1)

God allows His people to stumble not to fall away completely

Don't be afraid to speak with passion of the things of God

4] through trespass, salvation has come to the gentile so as to make Israel Jealous (11d)

Ie thru sin / judgement of God....salvation has been brought to the Gentiles ... effect of making Jews jealous Cf Trespass (5:15-20)

Nb Salvation to everyone who believes (1:16)

Ie Saved from God's wrath (5:9)

Cf Salvation (Lk 1:69,77; 2:30; 3:6; 19:9)

God uses even our sin for good.

IESUS Through all of our trespass Jesus brought salvation

5] If the trespass /failure of the Jews means riches for world / the gentiles – how much more their inclusion (12)

ie the Jews failure has brought blessing — How much more will their inclusion/ obedience!

Nb The riches of His glory (9:23)

Expect an outpouring of blessing when the Jews come in / believe.

Speaking to Gentiles - "No he hasn't"! (13-16)

1] speaking specifically to Gentiles (13a)

Cf you and rest of Gentiles (1:13)

Nb Apostle to the Gentiles (cf Acts 9:15; Gal 2:8)

God has sent His message to us Gentiles

2] 'glorify' my apostleship to the Gentiles to make my people (Jews)jealous(13b,14)

Cf Salvation is from the Jews (In 4:22)

God sent an apostle to the Gentiles – to welcome them in.

3] Their rejection – reconciliation...Their acceptance – life from the dead (15)

Ie Paul's gospel anticipates outpouring of blessing when Jews believe

Nb the wages of sin are death (6:23)

The Jews – an instrument of light and salvation to the world (Gen 12:3; Is 49:6)

Salvation is from the Jews (John 4:22)

Life from the dead – the restoration of all things (Mt 24:32,33) {Israel = fig tree}

4] Dough (first fruit) = holy – lump = Holy. Also root holy so are branches

Nb Figtree is a symbol of Israel (Matt 24:32)

Ie because forefathers consecrated so too descendants

Cf first fruits to the whole lump = holy (Nu 15:19-21)

(Cf believing and unbelieving spouse (1 Cor 7:14))

Attitude of Gentiles to Jews? (17-20a)

1] Arrogance (17,18)

a) Wild shoot grafted in now share in the 'richness of the root'

GRACE The root, God's promise to the patriarchs, is what sustains life of His people

b) You are supported by that root - not vice versa.

note - The root, promises to the patriarchs, is what sustain the tree — ISRAEL

Do not be arrogant to the Jews

- 2] Pride (19,20)
 - a) I have been grafted in their stead
 - b) Issue = belief

ie their unbelief and your belief.

Nb proud cf boasting excluded (3:27)

the work of God is to believe in the one he has sent (John 6:29)

God breaks off branches through unbelief

So Gentiles – do not be proud but fear(20b-)

1] Fear God

Be humble and fearful of God

2] God did not spare natural branches, and neither will He with 'wild' (21)

God is a serious / uncompromising judge

- 3] Note God's nature-(22)
 - a) the alternatives
 - 1) Kindness

God is kind - gracious and merciful

2) severity

Note the kindness and severity of God

b) the consequence – cut off

- 4] God can reinstate (23,24)
 - a) God's power to reinstate believing natural branches (23)

cf God welcomes back His repentant people (Lk15:22)

God is sovereign

b) The comparison – grafting in a wild to a cultivated or a natural branch (24)

nb The Christians = inheritors of, participants with the faithful Jewish 'stock' (1Pet 2:9,10)

* Appreciate your position as a wild shoot in the cultivated olive tree of Israel*

MP Don't be proud – if you were included in Israel by grace, how much more will God not reintroduce faithful Jews to the heritage of their forefathers.
