<u>Colossians 1:24-2:5 'Proclaim the mystery – Christ in you the hope of Glory' 4.02.18</u> (NIV Pew Bible Pg 1182/83)

Context

- 1] Paul to a young church, never visited, amidst great religious confusion,
- 2] He focuses on
 - 1) The person of Jesus God, Creator, Sustainer, Leader (1:15-18)
 - 2) The work of Jesus reconciliation between God and man (1:19-23) ??? Why the stress on 'mystery'? (1:26, 27; 2:2) The mystery is key the revealed fellowship the Spirit of Jesus

Paul's attitude (1:24)

1] Rejoice in His sufferings for them

Nb messianic woes - present (evil) age (Gal 1:3) birth pangs of new age. (Rom 8:22). Meantime, share in his sufferings (Jn 15:20, 21; Phil 3:10)

Nb Paul's sufferings (2 Cor 11:23-28)

Rejoice in our sufferings (Romans 5:3)... in the Lord always (Phil 4:4) suffering for people to whom he writes (2 Cor 1:16; Eph 3:13; cf 2 Tim 2:10) suffering with Christ (Rmns 8:17; Phil 3:10) warning of suffering (Acts 9:16)

- 2] Fill up His flesh what is 'still lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions *JESUS in Jesus, God suffers*
- 3] For His body, which is the church

Cf What you did for the least of my brothers, you did for me (Matt 25:40)

Rejoice in what you suffer for Christ on other's behalf

The church should expect to share in Christ's afflictions

His mission (1:25-27)

1] commission by G (25a)

God sends His people to do His Work

Expect God's call

- 2] to present the fullness of the Word of God (25b)
- *God gives His Word in all its fullness through the message of Jesus*
- *Look at Christ in all the Scriptures as God's Word in all its fullness*
- 3] (which is) the mystery
 - a) hidden in the past (26a)
 - b) disclosed to the saints (26b)
 - c) the chosen included the gentile (27a)

cf gentiles including Ephesians 3:2-6.

GRACE God chooses to make Himself known

- d) the glorious riches (lit riches of the glory) (27b) riches of His Glory (Eph 3:16)Rejoice in the hope of glory (Rmns 5:2)
 - e) = Christ in (among) you, the hope of glory (27c)

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nb Jewish Messiah- 'Christ' 24,27,28; 2:2,5 cf 1:1,2,3,4.........2:6,8,9,10,11 'Christ in (gk 'en') you' cf 'God dwelt among us' (gk en) (Jn 1:14) *God dwells among us / within us*
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His action (1:28-2:1)

- 1] Proclaim, admonish, teach with all wisdom (28a)
- *Proclaim Jesus with the intent of presenting people complete / perfect in Christ*
- 2] Present everyone perfect (mature??) in Christ (28b) Nb Be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect (Matt 5:48)
- 3] a struggle
 - a) in God's power (29)
- *Work to make Jesus known by His power*
 - b) for all of them (2:1)
- cf 'struggling' cf in prayer' (1:9)
- *Struggle for those Christians who you have not met*
- *Aim to make the mystery of Jesus known*

His purpose (2:2-5)

- 1] Encouraged in heart (2a)
- 2] United in love (2b) *Cf Eph 4:2ff*)
- 3] Understanding of the mystery of God (2c-3)
 - a) Christ (2c)
 - b) all treasures of wisdom and knowledge (3)

cf Mystery (1:26, 27; 2:2) – spoke to Greeks (cf 1 Cor 1:22b)?

Wisdom and Knowledge (2 Chron 1:10-12; Rmns 11:23)

Greeks seek wisdom --- Jesus the wisdom of God (1 Cor 1:22, 24)

He (the Holy Spirit) will guide you into all truth. (John 16:13)

God exists above all human wisdom and knowledge

- 4] Secure (4, 5)
 - a) not deceived by fine arguments (4)
- cf Gen 3:1ff; Rmns 16:18)

Orderly – not tossed about cf (Eph 4:14)

- *Don't waste time in 'fine sounding arguments'*
 - b) aware of Paul's presence in spirit (5)
- cf Absent in body, present in Spirit (1 Cor 5:3-5; 1 Thess 2:17)
- *Put your faith IN Christ*

Main Point - For all men our faith is that the King of the Jews is the way to Heaven

Key verse - Christ in (among) you the Hope of Glory' (27b)
